#### Mark 10: 35 - 45

#### The Request of James and John

<sup>35</sup> James and John, the sons of Zebedee, came forward to him and said to him, "Teacher, we want you to do for us whatever we ask of you." <sup>36</sup> And he said to them, "What is it you want me to do for you?" <sup>37</sup> And they said to him, "Grant us to sit, one at your right hand and one at your left, in your glory." <sup>38</sup> But Jesus said to them, "You do not know what you are asking. Are you able to drink the cup that I drink, or be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with?" <sup>39</sup> They replied, "We are able." Then Jesus said to them, "The cup that I drink you will drink; and with the baptism with which I am baptized, you will be baptized; <sup>40</sup> but to sit at my right hand or at my left is not mine to grant, but it is for those for whom it has been prepared."

### Questions for conversation

•I wonder what you have heard and thought from the Word today?

• I wonder what it looks like for the Christian community to be the slave of all?

•What one action can you or your church take in response to the Word today?

### Silence in Two Ways

Spend some time in silence sitting still (suggested 5 minutes). Close your eyes lightly. Sit relaxed but alert.

•You may like to say the prayer phrase "Mar-an-atha" (which means come Lord). Say this as four syllables. Do not try to think or imagine anything. If thoughts or distractions come simply return to saying the word.

•Or you may like "sitting with God" — a silent time in which we focus all our mind, heart and soul on the presence of God without trying to create it. Simply be still and open to God.

## Prayers for Others

And we give thanks for those who spend their lives bringing comfort and healing.

Help us to set aside self interest and pride and to give and receive the care that is needed and for those who lead a servant heart of love and respect for all.

#### Silence:

We give thanks servant Jesus who models a different greatness and leadership in a world hungry for power and position. Open our eyes and give us courage to follow you, that in serving the world it might be changed and reflect your kin-dom. In your name we pray. Amen.
