Jesus the Cause of Division

⁴⁹ "I have come to cast fire upon the earth, and how I wish it were already ablaze! ⁵⁰ I have a baptism with which to be baptized, and what constraint I am under until it is completed! ⁵¹ Do you think that I have come to bring peace to the earth? No, I tell you, but rather division! ⁵² From now on five in one household will be divided, three against two and two against three; ⁵³ they will be divided:

father against son
and son against father,
mother against daughter
and daughter against mother,
mother-in-law against her daughter-in-law
and daughter-in-law against mother-in-law."

We pray for unity within our congregation/ faith community. Tear down walls of division caused by personal preferences, and cultural biases. Help us to love one another as You have loved us, and to work together to build Your Kingdom.

Merciful God, hear our prayers. Empower us by your Holy Spirit to live lives that are pleasing to you. Help us to be bold witnesses to your love and justice in the world.
