She likes that time of day.

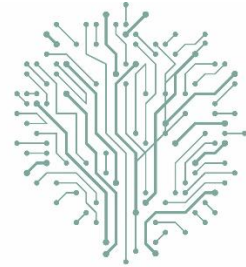
Mary likes to talk to strangers

Luke 10:38-42

Mary has chosen the better part, which will not be taken away from her."

The Message

Questions for conversation

- In what ways would you and your Christian community find new ways of being present before God?

Silence

Spend some time in silence sitting still (suggested 5 minutes). Close your eyes lightly. Sit relaxed but alert. Don't worry too much if your mind is filled with other thoughts, allow them to drift away like a feather on the wind. Listen to the deep stirrings of God.

Prayers for Others

Gracious God, trusting in your eternal welcome we lift our voices in prayer for your church, those in need and all creation. Merciful God, **hear our prayer.**

We pray for people in need: the ill, the homeless, the bereaved, the lonely, the desperate. Move us to act with compassion as we keep focus on your son, Jesus Christ. Merciful God, **hear our prayer.**

We pray for all creation, for places affected by climate change, for the just use of resources, for the care and treatment of all creatures. Merciful God, **hear our prayer.**

In all things O God, give us hearts filled with the compassion that comes from knowing we are loved by you. In Jesus name we pray, Amen.
