The Word around the Bush

Luke 17:11-19

On the way to Jerusalem Jesus was going through the region between Samaria and Galilee. As he entered a village, ten lepers approached him. Keeping their distance, they called out, saying, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!" When he saw them, he said to them, "Go and show yourselves to the priests." And as they went, they were made clean. Then one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, praising God with a loud voice. He prostrated himself at Jesus' feet and thanked him. And he was a Samaritan. Then Jesus asked, "Were not ten made clean? But the other nine, where are they? Was none of them found to return and give praise to God except this foreigner?" Then he said to him, "Get up and go on your way; your faith has made you well."

- When have you felt left because you were considered different?
- When have you left others out because you thought they were different, for whatever reason?
- What does it mean for you to feel that you belong to the immensity of the love and compassion of God?
- In what ways does your church let all people know they belong to the God of love, hope and mercy?

Spend some time in silence sitting still. If your mind begins to fill with too many concerns, picture them drifting away.

Prayers for Others and Creation

Eternal Presence, Constant Love, may we know your desire is for us to know you in our lives.
That we know we belong in your kingdom to the vastness of your love, mercy and compassion.
That we could share the immensity of your grace with others. That we could stand as those who embody the life we have been called to in Christ.
